Chef Shoe Q&A

When is the shoe available?

The shoes are currently stocked in our Sydney warehouse ready for immediate dispatch.

What is the RRP price?

\$110 incl. GST. Log-in to view wholesale price here.

Is there a minimum order?

There are no minimums.

What is the Product Code?

CWSH-BLK-shoe size. For example; CWSH-BLK-44 (for size 44).

Are the marketing resources available?

Yes. Available here.

Where are they made?

Made in Mexico.

From what material are they made?

60% recycled PVC.

Will they shrink?

No. Unlike competitor brands, made from EVA foam which shrinks with heat. Being recycled PVC, these do not shrink.

Are they non-slip?

Yes. They are slip-resistant to ASTMF2913-17 standard.

Are they Acid & Oil resistant?

Yes (they won't breakdown from oils & fats).

What makes them unique?

They have a bonded toe cap lining made from Aramid fibres, used in ballistic body armour, giving them their superior puncture and heat resistance above your foot and toe area.



Is the sole and heel glued on? (Will it come off?)

No, it is not glued. It is polymerized. So it will not fall apart.

How quickly do they wear out?

The sole material is enriched with nitrile; increasing wear resistance and oil resistance. They are built for kitchens, and also ideal for the medical industry.

Are they Unisex? How are they sized?

They have European Unisex sizing. Please refer to the size chart.

Do they have half sizes?

No. They have a double removable footbed to adjust for foot shape, for example, a wider foot.

How are they delivered/packaged?

They come on a plastic shoe hanger keeping them together, so they are easy to hang and display, without the need for additional packaging.
